The Jesse Tree Colouring in Ornaments

Instructions:

- 1. Print the colouring in sheets, as well as the list of biblical references to make things easier. I recommend printing the ornaments onto cardstock.
- 2. Colour in! You can choose to colour them all at once or you could colour each ornament on its corresponding day.
- 3. Cut each ornament out and hole punch the top. If you wish you can laminate them or cover them with clear contact paper so that they'll last more than one Christmas.
- 4. Tie a ribbon through each hole at the top of each ornament, with enough room to hang it on your Jesse Tree.
- 5. Beginning on December 1, place the first ornament on the tree and read aloud the attached bible verse. If you can, try to ask your children open ended questions about each verse. Continue in this manner through each day.

Note: You can attach these ornaments to your Christmas tree, to a smaller Christmas tree devoted just to this Jesse tree (there are many affordable ones at Kmart), or even draw a paper tree and stick them on.
